Mission Armenia provides a wide range of services to vulnerable groups through the Day Care Centers that the NGO has established in the regions and communities of the Republic of Armenia. Services are provided by multidisciplinary teams both at Day Care Centers and in the homes of beneficiaries, therewith making the vital assistance available also for the homebound people.

- Primary health
- Training
- Rehabilitative care (at 3 Centers)
- Prevention/rehabilitation services for the mentally disabled (at 3 Centers)
